The James M. Dunn Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Jim Dunn, who served for 31 years as a police officer in the Town of Barnstable. During that time, Jim worked in the schools as a D.A.R.E. officer and then as a resource officer. He was exceptionally dedicated to the children in his community, as well as his fellow officers and their families. To carry on Jim's legacy, the fund awarded its first scholarship to a graduating senior of Barnstable High School in the spring of 2012. Scholarships have been awarded each year since.

We are pleased to continue that tradition in Jim's honor. The fund will award a \$1000 scholarship to all children of active Barnstable Police Department officers who are graduating from high school and will be attending a two or four-year program and an accredited college.

In addition, an incredibly generous \$2500 scholarship has been made possible by the Barnstable Police Association. Every year this is funded by the association, with the scholarship board choosing the recipient. If applying for this scholarship, a written essay is required as described in the attached packet.

Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution the recipient is attending after successful completion of the first semester. Applicants are responsible for providing the Scholarship Board with the name and mailing address of that institution, and a copy of the first semester transcript with student I.D. number.
